

AFTER THE 2021 WHALEY LAKE BRIDGE DISASTER

How the Path to Beach 2 Was Rebuilt

Thanks to Volunteers and In-Kind Donations



After Hurricane Ida totally destroyed the Beach 2 Access Path, it has taken enormous efforts by volunteers and donations of materials to rebuild it.

The following is to recognize the dedication and consistent effort shown by some special residents and generous in-kind donors over the past year since Hurricane Ida destroyed our Beach 2 Path.

David and Andrea Cooper donated 30 Tons of Granite excavated from their yard, which Billy Colbert and John Hofweber moved to the washed out section of Lakeview Bridge Beach Path, past the white street drain pipe. The first five truckloads (30 Tons: 60,000 pounds) are shown pictured below. Billy Colbert/John Hofweber did the work.

Then J.P. Nilsen Excavating Delivered Four Truckloads, 20 Ton / 40,000lb. each, of Crushed Granite (only the Best Materials were used). John Hofweber of RTFI worked all day moving the first three 20 Tons (60 Tons Total) of Granite Stone material with RTFI equipment.

Matt Maneri moved the fourth Nilsen 20-Ton Delivery with his equipment and the fifth 20-Ton Truckload of Item #4 that was donated to Shore Haven from Peckham and trucked to us by R.F. Brill Excavating. Nilsen Excavating and R.F. Brill both were given 5- Star Google Reviews as a show of our appreciation.



Peckham Industries donated 150 tons of Item#4 which was trucked to us by R.F. Brill Excavating and Schmitt Excavating as in-kind donations to help us with our bridge, road and beach access repairs.



The First 20-Ton Truckload of 6-inch stone was donated by Rick Wilson.

The Second 20-Ton Truckload of 6-inch stone was donated by Amy Mazziotti.

The Third 20-Ton Truckload of 3/4 inch stone was donated by Brandon Kaiser and Ramon Orozco.

The Fourth 20-Ton Truckload of Item#4 was donated by Matt Maneri and moved with his equipment.

The Fifth 20-Ton Truckload of Item#4 was a Donation from Peckham Industries.

$30 + 20 + 20 + 20 + 20 + 20 + 5 = 135 \text{ TONS}$ or 270,000 pounds of material for Beach #2 Path

Bob Brill delivered three 20-Ton truckloads of Item#4 and James Schmitt delivered two truckloads of Item#4, all filled to capacity. This material was used to build the bridge and road.

Rick Wilson donated another 5 tons of stone (10,000 Pounds) for the top portion of the wall to make the path wider and finished the addition of the white road drain pipe after the path was completed.

Matt Maneri, Brandon Kaiser, Ramon Orozco, Amy Mazziotti and Paul Malichek also contributed their indispensable help all year which made a huge impact on overall success.

All volunteers and donors are deserving of our most sincere thanks. And, the volunteers continue to maintain the cleanliness of the path, stream and the bridge to keep it safe and beautiful. Let's all respect their hard work and work to keep it clean as well.
